



ADVANCED MANUFACTURING PATHWAY

Advanced manufacturing involves the setup and operation of a variety of computer and mechanically controlled machines used to produce metal parts, instruments and tools. Courses in this area will help you understand the machining and manufacturing process along with hands-on learning experiences. If a student chooses this pathway, each academic year (10, 11, 12) they will be required to take core classes (Math, English, Science and Social Studies) in addition to one required pathway class.
