Romeo High School video production teacher Stephany Harbison was named the Digital Arts, Film and Television (DAFT) 2025 Michigan Media Educator of the Year at the 57th Michigan Student Film Festival. The awards ceremony was held at the DIA's historic Detroit Film Theatre on Saturday, April 26.

According to the DAFT news release, Mrs. Harbison "has grown Romeo's media program into a standard of excellence known across the state for its unique balance of journalism, narrative filmmaking and community outreach.
