ABOUT THE BOND

Romeo Community Schools has a \$62 million zero-tax-rate increase Facilities Bond Proposal on the ballot to fund priority updates and upgrades to keep our schools safe and up-to-date.

If approved, the bond would replace the existing bond as it's paid off, which means no increase to the current tax rate residents are already paying.

The bond would focus on four key project areas for students, staff and the community:

- Stronger infrastructure
- Safer, more secure schools
- Updated classrooms and learning spaces
- Better arts, athletics and play areas
