On November 4, Romeo Community Schools will ask residents to vote on the **final phase of a long-range facilities plan** that began in 2016. This bond proposal would complete the remaining projects – **without increasing the current tax rate.**

FACTS ABOUT THE PROPOSAL

Zero-Tax-Rate Increase

- If approved, the bond proposal would replace expiring bond debt.
- This means no increase to your current tax rate.

Final Phase of the Long-Range Plan

- Continues the work started in 2016.
- Completes the remaining facility updates and upgrades district-wide.

Project Focus Areas

- Infrastructure Improvements
- Safety & Security Enhancements
- Learning Environment Updates
- Arts, Athletics, & Play Area Upgrades

BOND PROPOSAL PROJECTS INCLUDE:

IMPROVING SCHOOL INFRASTRUCTURE

New Facility Additions

- Hevel (special education wing), Washington (cafeteria), & Romeo High School (classroom wing)

Facilities Assessment Priority Projects

- Replacing heating & cooling equipment (boilers, chillers, HVAC units, water heaters, & pumps)
- Upgrading electrical systems and technology infrastructure
- Replacing soffits, metal siding, roofing components, masonry, & window glazing
- Replacing doors, ceilings, lighting, & flooring
- Upgrading technology infrastructure (cabling, digital displays, & backup power systems)
- Replacing the Indian Hills parking lot and replacing sidewalks at select facilities

ENHANCING SAFETY & SECURITY

- Reconstructing a new secure entry & main office at Hevel
- Upgrading security cameras, firewalls, PA, bell, phone, clock, & access control systems
- Replacing parking lot lighting, fencing, & gates
- Creating a new parent drop-off loop at Washington

UPDATING LEARNING ENVIRONMENTS

- Upgrading wireless network & audiovisual systems
- Renovating media centers at all elementary buildings & Romeo Middle School
- Creating a dedicated special education classroom wing at Hevel
- New Romeo High School educational wing (science lab, CTE, RVA, & general classrooms)

UPGRADING ARTS, ATHLETICS, & PLAY AREAS

- Renovating music rooms at Hevel & Washington
- Phase 2-elementary playground renovations
- Constructing a new auxiliary gym & turf practice field at Romeo High School
- Constructing a JV baseball field
